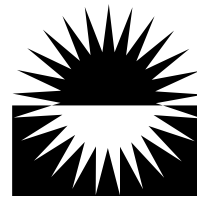
It's that time of the year again!

Don't miss out on all the fun and entertainment that will be people will be talking about until next year's conference.

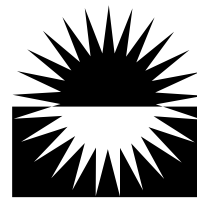
The cost is \$15 per student for the two days before January 31st and \$20 for one day. The costs after the 31st are \$50 for the two days and \$35 for one day.

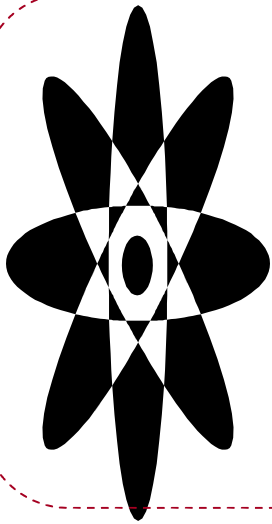

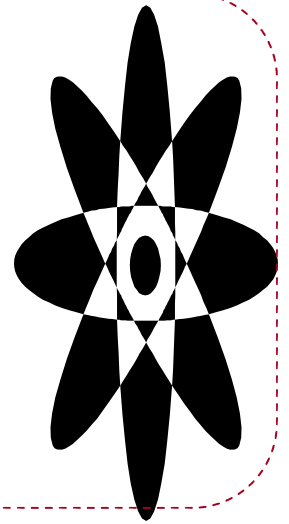

A love story between two young women of different and economic and social backgrounds who struggle to sustain a relationship despite hostility from their families.
